The paper examines the inter- and intra- regional spillover effects between regional labour productivity and growth in Denmark using an input-output computable general equilibrium (CGE) model. Overall, the paper is well written and thought-through although I have the following comments to improve the paper:

- 1. Since the study is using a CGE model then the literature review should review studies which similar models for other countries or regions. This will allow for comparison of the results with those previous literature (which is currently lacking in the paper).
- 2. The study could widen its policy implications and indicate what lesson other countries can learn from the findings.
