

Review of: "[Research Note] Dengue – Therapeutic Efforts in Mexico"

The authors have written on Dengue indicating that it is a major problem of Public health importance in Mexico.

The abstract appears more like an overview and an introduction to the topic. It lacks the subject matter that authors are addressing in the article.

The article title indicates therapeutic efforts on Dengue in Mexico which the authors start addressing in the first paragraph where they talk about the use of herbal medicine. Immediately this is interrupted by efforts on the mosquitoes and they go on to give out a lot of details on this and for a moment deviating from therapeutics. The next paragraph reverts to therapeutics again but this time talking about non herbal medicines.

I would suggest that the authors structure the abstract such it gives a summary of the subject matter being addressed.

In the body of the article, efforts on the mosquito vector should be mentioned in the introduction as background information on all the efforts being done on Dengue and details on treatment areas and their results summarised.

Authors should also discuss and provide their opinion and give recommendations.
