In my opinion, this study is only the beginning of a scientific work, because, as it stands, it is a study closer to journalistic reporting. The study makes too much use of quoted content from other studies, at the expense of its own reflections and conclusions. The paper pays too much attention to historical aspects without fully demonstrating their real relevance to contemporary solutions.

Neuroscience as an interdisciplinary field of knowledge represents a great potential, which the authors of the paper should use to prepare a more detailed, thoughtful and, above all, less chaotic analysis.

The current superficial consideration, which is a collection of citations more or less related to the title issue, has not reached a sufficient level for publication.

The reviewed study needs to be thoroughly rewritten and supplemented with one's own reflections, closely related to the title issue.

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
