Overall, the topic is interesting, described nicely; however following revisions are recommended to improve the clarity of the paper:

- 1) Proper supporting reference is missing in the first paragraph of introduction.
- 2) The meaning of the following sentence is not clear:

"Since time immemorial, economic and development theorists across the globe have underscored the importance of education for socio-economic inclusion and development (Alexander, 2020; Findlay & Kierzkowski, 1983; Oyinlola and Adedeji, 2021); Singh, et. al., 2022)"

- 3) The research objective and the research scope is missing in the introduction section
- 4) The authors need to elaborate the necessity of using the Distributed Cognition Theory
- 5) A 'Background Study' or 'Literature Review' section is missing in the paper.
- 6) Research gaps or research issues should be explicitly mentioned before proceeding to the theoretical framework
- 7) Please explain how 'Methodology' is coming after 'Output'.....
- 8) The cases should be discussed in a more structured manner.
- 9) Findings should be discussed under different sub categories with respect to theoretical contributions and managerial contributions
- 10) Proper use of punctuation is missing in many of the sentences.
