- 1. The introduction to the review paper can be modified, leading to the objective of writing this review work.
- 2. It would be better to include the mechanism of action of all the phytoconstituents mentioned in the paper.
- 3. A separate title/table can be given, and the plant's part-specific phytochemical constituents can be described.
- 4. Under 5.1. Antidiabetic activity
 - 1. "The acute toxicity study results demonstrated that the ethanolic extract of P. marsupium Roxb stem is non-toxic in the dose range of 250-1000 mg/kg". What about toxicity study results of other extracts?
 - 2. "The study results demonstrated that among the different fractions, the butanol fraction showed more what kind of activity than the other fractions?
- 5. **5.6** "Chauhan et al. investigated the methanol extract of P. marsupium Roxb for its memory enhancing activity in albino mice at 25 and 50 mg/kg p.o (what is p.o?, please expand) by elevated plus-maze and Morris's water maze test". It is not clear from the statement which part of the tree was used for this. Kindly specify if details are available.
- 6. **5.7** "The study determined the polyherbal formulation to be a hepatoprotective agent by increasing the SGOT, SGPT, ALP, and serum bilirubin also showed less hepatocyte cell damage [67]." The citation gives a better conclusion relevant to the sub-heading, i.e., Hepatoprotective activity. Hence, the subheading (under 5.7) may be modified for better understanding.
- 7. Try to incorporate original sentences rather than using the exact lines from the reference paper. The review paper needs to be elucidated for a better understanding of the readers.
- 8. Grammatical and typographical errors need to be rectified.

CONCLUSION: Major revision is required before publishing. The review article has marginal novelty or new information, nor does it report anything that has a substantial impact.

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
