Thanks for providing me an opportunity to review this interesting work based on an innovative idea. There are some points in this article that need improvement:

1. Abstract

In the focus of research, the researcher should not write the title of the research (as it is); rather, the focus must highlight some information related to key variables, scope, or significance of the research.

After stating the purpose of the research, the researcher is required to provide brief details about research design, study participants, data collection procedures, and data analysis techniques.

Instead of writing this sentence, "Three (3) research questions were raised to give the research a definite focus," soon after stating the purpose, the main crux of these research questions may be mentioned.

Add three to five keywords at the end of the abstract.

2. Introduction

Add the findings of 2 to 3 latest research studies to build an effective and strong rationale.

These two headings, "Statement of the Problem" and "Purpose of Study," may be merged and written as subheadings (as Purpose Statement) of the introduction section.

The text from "Self-reliant Education" till the heading "Methodology - Research Design" may be labelled as "Literature Review."

3. Methodology - Research Design

Prior to discussing the research design, briefly state the philosophical assumptions that were followed for this study.

Try to follow this sequence to state the methodology:

- Philosophical Assumptions
- Research Design
- Participants (Populations, Sample, and Sampling Techniques)
- Instruments
- Data Collection Procedures
- Data Analysis Techniques

Research questions may be written in the introduction section.

In the heading “Method of Data Collection,” mention clearly that either the checklist was adopted, adapted, or self-developed, and how its validity and reliability were ensured?

4. Restate this section “Conclusion: Prospects of Recrafting Self-Reliance Policy” as “Conclusions and Discussion,” and in this section, discuss the findings of the data in light of other studies.

5. In “Recommendations,” give practical recommendations based on data analysis.
