INTRODUCTION

The author has not managed to link variables under study. The linkage of Social, Economic, and Cultural are not indicated, which is a very big miss for this paper. The author has not stated the history or status of Social Work in the world or T/A Chimwala. The authors also need to state the problem existing, the challenges, and the objective or research questions of the paper.

METHODOLOGY

This cannot be accepted in the current form; the author needs to improve by stating the following in detail: Description of the study area needs to be very clear with selection criteria, Data collection (what tools, who are respondents, type of question asked?) sampling procedure need to be well stated. Data analysis is not presented.

Results

The term result is not indicated, and what is termed as a result is hard to understand because this work lacks objective or research questions. However, Social, Economic, and Cultural Factors would have been presented separately to make this paper meaningful as, in its current form, it is hard to differentiate the same.

Again, I advise the author to separate results and discussion sections because, as it stands, most of the results are not discussed.
