The objectives of the app and the goals of this manuscript should be stated more explicitly in the abstract and introduction. The literature review has not been updated. Many broad generalizations are made without any backing from prior research. The methodology needs greater statistical and scientific support because it is inadequate. The discussion section needs to be updated and is written poorly; it ought to be based on the findings of the study. The challenges that need to be addressed include app compatibility across various platforms/operating systems, internet connectivity issues, the personal touch of the therapist, and many more. Numerous grammatical and semantic mistakes in the paper need to be corrected. The work needs extensive reworking and lacks much uniqueness.

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
