

Review of: "The anti-staphylococcal activity of probioticcontain gelatin and whey coatings on processed chicken breast"

Food safety is of utermost importance and as the bacteria is day by day getting resistant so it is necessary to find new ways to tackle it. The reported work is quite unique and the manuscript is well structured. I like to suggest few points to the authors;

- 1. There are some typographical mistakes in the manuscript such as in abstract line 2 (Lactobacillusplantarum and Bifidobacterium bifidum bacteria must be omitted and names of bacteria must be written as Lactobacillus plantarum and Bifidobacterium bifidum. In line 11, space should be given between of and B. bifidum. In Introduction, paragraph 1 line 6 pathogenicity must be written instead of pathogenic. In paragraph 3 line 3 of Introduction, it is written as self-life, it should be shelf-life. In paragraph 2 line 5 of Introduction it is written as (It is should) here 'is' must be removed. There are some more typographical and grammatical mistakes in the manuscript. So I suggest that it should be checked thoroughly.
- 2. The next thing which I want to suggest is that title must be modified as although the coated chicken showed less bacterial count as compare to the control but it is increasing with time so it doesn't suggested the antibacterial effect rather it is just showing the delaying effect of the coating. So this statement must be clarified and should be supported with literature.

These are the points which I wanted to suggest. I highly recommend the publication of this manuscript but I think these suggestions must be addressed. I wish best of luck to the authors.

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
