

Review of: "Climate Change and Sustainability: A Comparative Case Study"

Climate change and sustainability have become important topical issues globally, and this article could be a relevant contribution to the discourse through the comparative analysis of efforts in Sweden and India.

I have three main comments:

1. The authors chose to describe efforts in each country separately, which suggests that these efforts are not similar. It would have been more instructive to compare similar efforts at climate change mitigation and sustainability.
2. The article merely describes, in broad generalised terms, efforts made by the two countries on climate change and sustainability, without presenting any statistics that would give indications of the extent to which these efforts are measurable in real terms. It is purely descriptive and does not provide any tangible information that can be a benchmark for assessing the performance of other countries against the efforts in Sweden and India, and I think this is a major gap in the narrative.
3. It is not clear what the house style of the Journal is, but I think it would be appropriate that the authors adopt the standard protocol for referencing.
