It is with great pleasure that I receive the invitation to review this important article. So here we go with some suggestions:

- 1. Covid-19 cases and articles (and reviews) have been keeping attention worldwide since 2020. The n of this research seems to be quite a little bit little regarding the number of papers published;
- 2. Also, it is important to separate the occular venous and arterial occlusion articles from those on vasculitis, which seems to be the goal of this one;
- 3. I haven't found any notes about comorbidities, which I find interesting because hemorrhages, cotton wool spots, arterial and venous occlusions may be present in other diseases such as diabetes and systemic arterial hypertension;
- 4. In my study, here in Brazil, for example, we have found a relation of these ocular findings with the clinical presentation the patients had before;
- 5. There are no notes about the diagnosis and treatment of vascular disease, information about the interval since the Covid infection, the diagnosis, and how the treatment for Covid was administered, neither their vaccine condition at that time;
- 6. The discussion must be more constructive and comparative.

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
