First of all, congratulations to the author of the manuscript. The study analyses in depth the management of staff from the beginning of their research career towards retirement. However, I believe that the manuscript can be improved in several ways:

- 1) Literature Survey: This part of the manuscript should be a bit deeper in relation to the existing literature on the analysed topic. It would make a greater contribution to the study.
- 2) The manuscript would be improved if the Indian university context is analysed to understand the particularities described in the empirical part of the study.
- 3) Sample: I think that the sample should be explained in detail to determine whether it is significant or not for the population. To do this, the study should propose a descriptive analysis of the sample in terms of age, ranks, ...
- 4) Parts I to VII: I think that the existing literature and the comments or ideas expressed by the members of the sample should be included.
- 5) Discussion: In this part of the manuscript, you should relate the ideas expressed in the results. From this perspective, a summary table can be a clear contribution to your manuscript.
- 6) Conclusions: I think there should be more specific conclusions of the study. In this section, you should propose new ideas that may benefit the specific university context and/or how to extrapolate the model to other university contexts.

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
