The article is very interesting and well-written. The methodology is rigorous with great results. However, the duration of the data, more than 10 years back, does not give a true picture of the situation. For decision-making, the data concerned only one region out of 13. In addition, the hospitals in this region are not among the largest in the country, so they cannot be representative of the country's regions. The title should therefore be revised. Good prevention is generally 6 prenatal consultations with at least 90 doses of iron/folate and two preventive treatments for malaria.
