To enhance the quality of the manuscript further, the following suggestions are provided for the author's reference:

1. The first chapter of the manuscript primarily elucidates the research background and motivation, leading to the presentation of the research objectives and the topic under investigation. It may be beneficial to integrate the second chapter with the first to create a more cohesive narrative.
2. A literature review helps readers or reviewers understand the current state of research on the issues addressed in this study and the existing gaps. While the author has consulted a substantial amount of literature, the focus has been more on introductions. It is recommended to analyze the existing literature, compare their similarities and differences, and explore the insights these studies offer to the author of this manuscript. This situation is evident in chapters two to four and requires further refinement.
3. Is the fifth chapter dedicated to research methods? Interdisciplinary thinking, trends, and tools are crucial aspects, but how do they hold value for the issues investigated in this research? This needs to be elaborated upon based on the literature review. A similar situation exists in the sixth chapter.
4. The research conclusions are relatively clear. However, considering the issues mentioned earlier, it is advisable to revisit and adjust the research conclusions after further revisions or additions to the entire manuscript.
