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This article is an opinion article that provides a discussion on earlier and current influence of UK in African health system. The article advocates to improve the access to healthcare for marginalized section of the society. The article has been written nicely. Some recommendations for improving current draft are given below:

- Currently, the article does not seem to follow a standard structure of an opinion article. A standard structure as given below can be adopted:
 - Abstract
 - Introduction: that describes the importance of the topic of the proposed study.
 - Background: that describes the research and literature related to the topic of study.
 - Viewpoints of the experts on topic: Primary data collection from experts is needed and some statistical technique may be utilized for analysis.
 - Conclusion
- There are various statements that can be tested for statistical significance. E.g. "preprints from the African continent are over 50% less likely to be published as full peer-reviewed papers". This will enhance the value of the article.
- Please check the English presentation of this article to remove the typos and grammatical mistakes. E.g. following sentence in the fourth line of Page no. 6, seems grammatically inaccurate:
" Furthermore, the majority of first authors are African and last authors female".
- Recommendations of this article can be discussed more in the conclusion section.
