Could you determine which term to use? "Kali" or "Braminy raptor"? I recommend using the scientific name for this species, considering this is a scientific journal. And how does the Author identify this species precisely while it is seeing?

Figure 3 should be corrected, and there needs to be more information on this location. The legend must be clear.

The Author's step by step of collecting Macro, Meso, and Micro-scale data seems to need more structure. You have to think about the audience reading your manuscript to convey the information well without being hidden. Could you table which activities fall into each observation scale (Macro, Meso, and Micro)?

What tools do you use for correlation analysis?

Figure 6, please be presented with a better table, not just a screenshot. You can rearrange a new table with a neat presentation format.

So, what actual results can you present? The words (sentences) you submit in the results section are more suitable to be placed in the Methods section. This means that here you are not showing the "RESULTS" correctly. You only move the correlation results table. Then, what do you think about your review of the findings?
