This study aims at investigation the epidemiology of HIV/HBV co-infection in Yenagoa, Nigeria. Unfortanately, I think this sample size is too small to make inferences within this population. Since the sample size are small, the effects of the different factors assessed are not really perceptible.

There are some discrepancies in the study. For example, a higher HIV/HBV coinfection rate occurred among females(3.0%) than in males(0.0%). The description was contrary to data in Figure 3.

The literature cited in this study is abundant, but it is not advisable to simply list the similar literature, which needs further induction and sorting.
