The article is interesting and overall well-written. The topics are presented in a good and clear structure and English is generally correct. However, I suggest to the author to deep the bibliography, adding more recent literature results on collaborative digital storytelling in education and collaborative learning with digital technology more in general. A more specific focus on literature findings will also help the author to delve more deeply the theoretical background of the model proposed. Furthermore, it should help a more sofisticated in depth-study on the behavioural and learning aspects of students on which this methodological approach should be based.

A further focus should then be made on the subjects of special educational needs and inclusion, if emphasis is to be placed on that, as the author does in several versions of the paper.

All the above, I find the paper interesting and potentially very relevant, so I strongly suggest that the author pay more attention to the above-mentioned aspects.
