The manuscript examines the impact of CPTED practices on urban life in the context of two different neighbourhoods. The study incorporates quantitative surveys, qualitative interviews and comprehensive field observations to answer the initial hypothesis. Innovation is present throughout the paper, but briefly summarising these features may help to disseminate the study.
