In the results section of the abstract, kindly state that these significant associations are between poor glycemic control and higher total cholesterol, triglycerides, and AIP or lower.

Conclusion: Please rephrase the conclusion section of the abstract to be more concise and clearer and based on the results of your study.

Introduction:

Kindly rephrase "micro and macrovascular" as "microvascular and macrovascular."

Since you have the "TC" abbreviation for "total cholesterol," please write the full form of this term for the first time and only use "TC" for the rest of the manuscript.

Methods:

State the exact inclusion criteria for your patient selection with T2DM.

Add the reference for the Declaration of Helsinki.

Please state the ethical committee approval code for your study.

Add the range for good HbA1C levels (<7 %).

Results:

Kindly state that the significant relationship between HbA1c categories and age and BMI is regarding the association between HbA1c and higher or lower age and BMI.
