However, it needs major improvements before it can be published

In my opinion, the literature review should be deeper, especially in the field of sociology and philosophy of AI - some important authors are missing. For example: how to talk about strong AI without addressing the problem of consciousness (Chalmers or Dennet)? how to talk about superintelligence without talking about the work of the Swedish philosopher Nick Bostrom? or how to talk about the dangers of AI without mentioning Stuart Russell?,

The research methodology is not explicit, so it is not clear how the implications and conclusions are reached. This aspect greatly weakens the article because it sounds to the reader like an opinion article rather than a scientific article.
