The article outlines some interesting ideas that could lead to a useful theory/model for the decision of “staying” (or “not migrating”) in a context of adversity. But, in my opinion, it lacks systematization as, in its present redaction, the concepts are somehow disperse and redundant. Also, the empirical exercise seems to rely only on some qualitative interviews in a single village. With a proper revision of the theoretical model and maybe more practical examples, it should develop into a quality paper.
