

## Review of: "Factors influencing women's decision choosing a public or private health facility for tuberculosis (TB) services: An analysis of Nepal demographic and health survey data 2016"

Thank you for allowing me to review this manuscript. Some my comments to increase the quality of the paper.

- 1. The title should be simplified. It was too long.
- 2. Abstract; The objective does not tally with stated in the last paragraph in the background. Please make it a standard objective. Results: 95% CI should be written in each stated variable. There were only stated for women having good TB knowledge, other than that only stated CI.
- 3. Background: The citations 1-16, there were too old references. 6/16 having more than 15 years of publications. The last paragraph talks about the objective, but it does not tally with the objective stated in the abstract.
- 4. Sampling and sample size: suggested to include a flow chart regarding the identified sample size (13089) until the final sample (10119). Why did you choose women aged 15-49, based on what criteria? The time frame for data collection should be mentioned in the manuscript.
- 5. Independent variable: Knowledge was divided into 3 categories, based on what criteria and how it was divided?
- 6. Results: Descriptive analysis, suggested to state the percentage (%) after one-third, two-thirds etc.

General; You are using the data from 2016, but will be published in 2023, which means that 7 years ago. Is it worth it to publish and report the factors influencing women's decisions because it was considered outdated, and might change a lot of information in terms of family size, ecological region, media exposure, etc.
