This paper state the position of Societies of Oral Pathology and Medicine (SIPMO) and of Maxillofacial Surgery (SICMF) on regards to MRONJ. It is an updated version with some changes from the 2013 and 2020 edition. The position paper aligns with the current best evidence available on this topic and is divided into several sections that addresses important controversies related to MRONJ, such as definition, epidemiology, signs/symptoms, imaging, diagnosis, and treatment. The paper places particular emphasis on the issue of drug holiday and the refinement of surgical treatment based on risk. It is well written and clear on the explanation for the reasons of the recommendations. One of the paper's strengths is its detailed exploration and refinement of the issues that have been debated in this field. The emphasis on the radiological findings on diagnosis and treatment is also important. However, in my opinion the methodology section could benefit from additional details about the processes employed in the paper's development. It would be beneficial to include specific details, such as the databases utilized and the date of the last search, as this would provide crucial context for the recommendations outlined in the paper.
