The authors could strengthen the paper by increasing the sample size of transport experts. The authors could also discuss the potential impact of the findings on transport policy and planning.

Overall

This is a well-written and informative paper that makes a valuable contribution to our understanding of the gendered transport sector in Karachi. The paper would be strengthened by addressing the weaknesses identified above.
