The hypotheses should be rewritten in the format given below

H1: Within Zimbabwe's service-based enterprises' industry, there exists a positive relationship between the economic responsibilities of Corporate Social Responsibility and Corporate Social Performance.

Describe the target population from which sample is drawn.

Measurement model assessment should be written more concisely.

descriptive analysis should precede measurement model assessment

limitations and future directions should be written in paragraph format
