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The study was reviewed under the title (Thermal and Packaging-Related Nanoparticles in Food: Formation Pathways, Migration Mechanisms, and Toxicological Considerations). Several spelling and grammatical errors were identified, along with mistakes in word usage. In addition, the overall format of the article gives the impression of being generated by artificial intelligence, although I did not have access to an AI detection tool to verify this. The following issues should be addressed:

In systematic review articles, it is preferable to include the phrase "systematic review" in the title.

The citation style for Table 1 is inconsistent. Furthermore, the table title is placed below the table, whereas it should appear above it.

The section labeled "Declaration" appears after the references, while it is typically presented before the reference list.
