My comments about this paper:

- 1. In the abstract, authors need to summarize more concisely and focus the abstract on the background, methods, findings, and research implications.
- 2. In the introduction, the author has not written about the motivation and urgency of the research. The problem of the stagnant FMCG condition is only mentioned in a non-specific manner, without specifying what the problem is and when the stagnancy in the FMCG sector in India began.
- 3. In the literature review, previous studies within the last five years need to be added.
- 4. In the methodology section, the author should explain the rationale for using the judgment sampling method, which eventually led to selecting the top 5 largest companies. In responding to the research objective of describing the financial distress conditions in the FMCG sector, it is advisable to expand the sample.
- 5. In the conclusion, the author should mention the limitations of the research and provide recommendations for future studies.

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
