This article showcases commendable writing skills, a well-structured narrative, and a smooth flow of ideas. It effectively addresses critical concerns related to EVs and includes satisfactory references. However, from an academic standpoint, it lacks empirical research, both qualitative (such as in-depth interviews with EV owners, dealers, and industry experts) and quantitative (comprehensive surveys targeting representative groups like early EV adopters or the early majority). The absence of these empirical research components means that the paper offers limited contributions to the existing body of knowledge and may be perceived more as an opinion piece, a perspective article, or an extensive newspaper feature, rather than a scholarly work.
