The paper is a narrative review dealing with the antibacterial and antifungal activity of Ganoderma sp. The manuscript is not well-organized and needs a deep revision. The authors should first give information about the Ganoderma genus and species, then about their antibacterial and antifungal activity (lacking a corresponding subheading). Furthermore, information about diabetic foot ulcers can be added. Some sentences are not clearly written; for example, "These are just a few examples of *Ganoderma* species, and there are many more within the genus such as *G. pfeifferi*, *G. oregonense*, *G. multipileum*, *G.adspersum*, *G. sessile*, *G. lipsiense*, *G. colossus*, *G.curtisii*, *G.lobatum*, *G. mbrekobenum*, *G. sinense*, *G. tornatum*, *G. tuberculosum*, *G. zonatum*, *G. miniatocinctum*, and *G. weberianum*etc." This sentence is non-sensical and should be more properly rewritten.

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
