The abstract does not clarify the main objective of the paper. The results are not included in the abstract.

The lack of a classic introduction in the paper is sensible.

The name of one of the software used (NetLogo) is not a proper keyword.

The texts in the figures are not in English, while the paper's language is English. This is really strange.

We can see various citation formats in the text! The first numerical citation is [28]!! It must be [1]. On the other hand, the bibliography (References) is not numerical at all!

"GIS" should be written in capital letters.

Existence of a map of the study area is necessary for the paper.

Screenshots of the software are not suitable for a scientific paper.

The research has no implementation. It only suggests using NetLogo as a software of ABM for the addressed subject (Tourism). In my idea, this is not a research!
