It is certainly a good idea to talk about the implementation of a comprehensive One-Health approach to the control of mosquito-borne diseases in Indonesia, as much as anywhere else with this problem. How to accomplish this administratively, however, was not described. The most feasible way to proceed is to build it up from the pre-existing infrastructures currently available for mosquito control in Indonesia, and to describe their changes or modifications needed with the introduction of the One-Health concept to streamline the operation. The latest developments in technologies for the effective control of mosquitoes also need to be introduced and discussed. This is important to recruit resources of cutting-edge technical expertise to implement the One-Health approach.
