A green to black colored, inorganic compound that turns yellow and produces toxic gases upon heating. Nickel monoxide is used in the electronics, ceramics, steel and alloy industries. Exposure to this substance can cause severe dermatitis, skin and asthma-like allergies and damages the lungs, kidneys, gastrointestinal tract and neurological system.
