

Review of: "A Review of Prosody, Punctuation, and Dyslexia: Implications for the Use of Speech Technologies"

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Existing comments summarize my opinion about this paper better than I could do myself. Still, I believe the relations between prosody and syntax must be re-examined, considering that prosody may not reflect syntactic properties, but on the contrary, syntax may reflect prosodic properties, i.e. that the syntactic structure reflects properties of the prosodic structure, both in oral and silent (implicit) speech. Such a change of point of view, while taking account the synchronization of accent phrases (thus stressed syllable) perception with delta brain oscillations may lead to a better comprehension of dyslexia.

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
