Overall, the author has made a good effort to delve into an interesting topic. However, in its current form, the paper appears to be a short one. Elaboration on few aspects and also exploring few underexplored areas (as mentioned below) could improve the overall quality of the paper.

- 1. The introduction appears to be quite short. It does not seem to motivate the topic or the research question adequately. The authors might want to elaborate on the background of digital transformation in Bangladesh more.
- 2. Although findings from different countries have been highlighted, more elaboration as to how each of the paper explores the challenges of digitisation is needed. This can be then used to understand the case of libraries in Bangaladesh.
- 3. In addition to existing findings, the author might also want to highlight the recent/existing efforts by policy makers/policies that enabled digitisation of libraries in Bangladesh. This could provide reader better context as to the progress of policy aspects.
