2. Introduction

3. Methods

1. Figures/Pictures: A map of the location of the study may be helpful.
2. Drones: What drones were you using? I would include the drone type, manufacturer, and the height at which the drone was flown.

4. Results

1. While the violin plot is informative, it might be helpful to suggest adding more figures or tables that summarize key results, such as a table comparing the dive and surface times across different locations or conditions.
2. Could the sound or size of the drone have affected diving and surfacing behavior?
