It can be good research. There are a few comments that I want to highlight.

- 1. The abstract should contain about 10% introduction, 10% aims and objectives, 20% methodology, 40% main findings, and 20% for conclusion and future work. The abstract should already define what ECO-CSB and ECO-CSSB are.
- 2. Introduction part There are no citations throughout the content, especially when you have numbers and data. Too long; at first, it looks like a review paper.
- Methodology part It should be written in a way that allows others to duplicate the experiments when they read your methodology. I don't see any ECO-CSB additives except in the abstract. The quality of the figures needs to be improved.
- 4. Results and Discussion part I would prefer the results to be presented in graphs. The description and justification of each table/graph should be discussed immediately. It is suggested to include citations/findings from previous studies to support and strengthen the results and justification.

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
