In table 1, authors have associated age with prevalence of TTIs, there are not many participants in age group 51-60 and 61-65, so I would like to suggest that authors should remove data of people aged with age ranging from 51-65 y and then analyze the data. It is interesting to note that females are more hesitant to donate the blood in Cameroon (case stand similar with Low income countries) what are reasons of blood donation hesitancy among females needs to be spelled out in discussion section.
