Definition: A tobacco-containing product in which the tobacco is processed to enable absorption of a some tobacco constituent through an epithelial membrane.

Comment: This class does not include products whose only tobacco-related constituent is nicotine. Those are in the class of nicotine-containing products. It includes chewing tobacco and snus. Epithelial membranes are typically the oral and nasal mucosae.

Definitions also often require elaboration to make it clear how they should be used and what they include. In those cases we include a comment.

Also, definitions sometimes require an explanation as to how they came about to help users understand how they relate to alternative definitions. In those cases we include a curator note.
