Review of: "Non-Invasive Prenatal Testing (NIPT) for Aneuploidy in a Setting with a High Consanguineous Rate – A Retrospective Cohort Review of 1,153 Cases"

This study was a retrospective review of records of all women who had NIPT at a single feto-maternal centre. This study compared 6 commercial NIPT brands and also looked at the failure rate of NIPT in consanguineous vs non-consanguineous groups. Overall, the study rationale, methods, results and conclusions are clearly stated.

Some minor comments:

- 1. Define all acronyms and abbreviations the first time they appear
- 2. Specify degree of consanguinity and if there are any significant associations between the degree of consanguinity and failure rates.
- 3. Please comment on whether pre- and/or post-test genetic counselling is routine? What are your thoughts around this?
- 4. What information are patients given about the various commercial brands available? What factors do they take into consideration when choosing one of these brands?
