- 1. There are a number of sentences that are incomplete. Do check through the paper and make the necessary changes.
- a. For instance- those that has the word undertake or undertaking. ... Check on those and it will be good to make the necessary changes. (The low quality of current jobs around the world and their scarcity have led to the need to undertake the career of entrepreneurship).
- b. the sentence starting with <u>however</u> is done twice one after the other sentence (check the conclusion section and make the necessary changes).

OECD-Graph 1) with (Latin America and members of OECD-Graph 2) will be good with brief explanation. This can be followed by Graph 3.

- 6. In page 14, it is mentioned to refer Figure 4 which does not exist. Check on this and amend accordingly.
- 7. In the discussion part, it will be better to relate the findings with past studies especially the variables which are found to have impact.
