The idea put forward in this opinion article is very interesting, although in my humble opinion, it needs to be further developed.

More than an opinion piece, it seems to be a review of the concept of a competence framework and what the European Commission has researched/published.

It is a first approximation of what could be a publishable scientific article, with ample room for improvement. I recommend, if you have a scientific journal in mind, to review your topics, other articles, deepen the theoretical framework, methodology, broaden or deepen the competence frameworks, results, and conclusions.

Lastly, if the standard used is APA 7th edition, I would recommend reviewing the citations (order of authors, capital letters, brackets, etc.) and the bibliographic references because the standard is not well applied.

Also, check the citations in the figures because they are incomplete, in addition to mentioning the authorisation for the use of the figures.
