

Review of: "A New Record of *Elymnias Caudata* Butler, 1871 (Insecta: Lepidoptera: Nymphalidae) from Nagpur in Central India"

I consider it appropriate to publish notes like this one to help understand the distribution patterns of different species. The main suggestions I can make to try to improve their quality are: 1) check that all scientific names at the genus and species level are written in italics. 2) Common names, such as tailed palmfly, nymphali, and family, should be written in lowercase. 3) The palm species, *Chrysalidocarpus lutescens*, should be written in italics and provide the author and year of the species. 4) It would be very useful to have a photograph of the SMMCS campus and the host plant. 5) Based on the references, it can be useful to say how many butterfly species have been recorded for Nagpur and update the figures. 6) Not to abbreviate the genus name later at any point.
