The article had syntax errors and repetition of specific points mentioned earlier, which have been highlighted and need corrections. The topic also needs to be modified.

Comments:

Citations: Some statistics needed to be cited, questioning the authenticity of the values.

Recommendation: The author should cite articles correctly and avoid repeating points to ensure a logical progression of ideas. Transitioning sentences must be inserted to prevent readers from losing interest halfway through the article. The author should organize the limitations, create a separate section for recommendations, and shorten the conclusion.

Conclusion:

Overall, it is a well-thought-out report that will contribute to the body of knowledge and improve the health outcomes of cancer patients in that community.
