An orally bioavailable capsule formulation of the inorganic toxic compound arsenic trioxide (As₂O₃), with potential antineoplastic activity. Although the mechanism of action (MoA) of As₂O₃ is not well understood, upon oral administration of ORH 2014, As₂O₃ appears to bind to DNA, prevent DNA synthesis, and cause DNA fragmentation, which leads to an induction of apoptosis in proliferating cells, including tumor cells. In addition, As₂O₃ causes damage to and induces degradation of the promyelocytic leukemia protein/retinoic acid receptor-alpha (PML/RARα) fusion protein, and inhibits the activity of the enzyme thioredoxin reductase.
