The study reveals that bakers adopted significant changes in operational methods as survival strategies, such as reducing shifts and production volume due to wheat scarcity. Bakers who continued operating post-ban employed new marketing strategies, while financial arrangements saw little change, with personal and family sources remaining primary funding.
