It would be good to know about the language family of the Bidayuh Somu language and any previous works available on the language with regards to the given topic. In Table 6, m- occurs before the bilabial p, n- before the alveolar s. The selection of these prefixes and others in the article with the syllables, however, seems to be sporadic and not morpho-phonologically conditioned. I think the authors could have specified this feature somewhere in the end or Conclusion.
