This is a very interesting article that addresses the common problem of Long Covid symptoms.

The tested therapy, even if suggestive, has been tried on a really tiny sample of patients, with different problems (depressive status...) and only with off-label drugs that seem to be now under tests in a cancer patients group, with no results yet.

I would suggest, if I can dare, to enlarge the cohort of homogeneous patients and ask the opinion of different immunologists to have a more sound background. On the other hand, my experience with LC is limited to sensory impairment, and I cannot properly evaluate the technical aspects of this paper.

I would suggest to repeat the list of symptoms and their acronyms also in the "Introduction" and not only in the "Abstract."
