For the diagram, the drawing does not show new information and should add the structure of the brain that is related to the blood vessels in the diagram to make it easier to understand.

Regarding vocabulary, there should be a check for accuracy and the accuracy of the content. For example, the posterior communication artery should be the posterior communicating artery. The posterior communicating artery is not a branch of the basilar artery, but a branch of the internal carotid artery that joins the posterior cerebral artery to form the arterial circle of Willis.
