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Congratulations, Sharma, et al., for showing your transformation journey from Heparin to citrate anticoagulation. I have a few suggestions that would make the manuscript helpful for other readers.

1. Can you provide specific examples or details on how the RCA protocol, including calcium monitoring, could be improved or clarified?
2. What additional information could be included about the training process for nurses to help other ICUs implement RCA effectively?
3. Was the efficiency of CRRT with heparin and RCA monitored?
4. Complications, e.g., bleeding, acid-base disturbances, severe hypocalcemia.
5. Could you explain the patient mobilisation in relation to pump speed?
